C-M PowderGard is a new desiccant dust insecticide which provides a mechanical method of protection against a wide variety of pests. These pests include but are not limited to Ants (including Fire Ants, Pharaoh Ants and Carpenter Ants), Aphids, Crickets, Earwigs, Fleas, Flies (including White Flies and Stable Flies), Mites, Roaches, Silverfish, Spiders, Scorpions and Ticks.

The dust may be used in commercial greenhouses or nurseries. It can be applied to sod farms, grass grown for seed and golf courses.

C-M PowderGard is NOT toxic to aquatic life and does not pose a runoff risk to adjacent areas.

C-M PowderGard is an unrestricted broadcast insecticide and may be Sold, Used and Stored by Non-Commercial Applicators. Please refer and follow all local and state regulations concerning the application of spray and dust insecticides.

Please use common agricultural and manufacturing procedures when using C-M PowderGard. Proper clothing is recommended, including but not limited to mouth and nose mask filter, enclosed eye protection, long pants and shirts, enclosed shoes and chemical resistant gloves

Keep out of reach of children and pets.

Compatibility and plant safety: C-M PowderGard is comprised mainly of a mild alkaline earth mineral. Avoid contact with acids.

Restricted Entry Interval (REI): None, limited only to residual dust with dry application or drying time

for liquid application. PPE required early reentry to treated areas that is permitted under the Worker Protection Act and involves contact with anything treated such as plants or soil is: Long sleeved shirt, long pants, shoes and socks, chemical resistant gloves.

Application can be made by aircraft or ground power equipment. Pour recommended amount of material into a half filled tank. Add balance of water. Maintain agitation during filling and spraying operation. Do not allow liquid slurry to stand.

Phototoxicity Testing has shown not to harm to plant when used at labeled rates.

Application Instructions:

Read entire label and use in accordance with label instructions.

Spray Bottle (Liquid mixture) (UPC #: 8-52779-00101-2)

- (1) The spray bottle comes with 4 ounces of C-M PowderGard, and treats up to 250 sq. ft. Unscrew the pump and nozzle by turning counter-clockwise.
- (2) Fill with water to 40 ounce level. Screw spray unit back on clockwise
- (4) SHAKE the bottle vigorously.
- (5) Pump several times until pressure is noticeable while pumping.
- (6) Press down on the spray trigger and adjust the spray for a wide-area application. Occasionally shake the bottle as the powder will settle at the bottom otherwise.
- (7) Spray directly on the area to be treated, Concentrate spray in areas of high insect traffic
- (8) If spray nozzle becomes clogged while misting; adjust nozzle for a stream spray, press trigger and readjust back to misting spray.
- (9) If all contents are NOT used. At the end of the application, turn the tank upside down and release all pressure and where only air is coming from nozzle.
- (10) For next use, SHAKE well; spray as directed.

Refill Spray Bottle (Liquid mixture):

- (1) 1 ounce of C-M PowderGard with every 10 ounces of water. (1:10)
- (2) Unscrew sprayer and follow directions as above.
- (3) DO NOT USE this spray unit for any other mixture ratios.
- (4) For larger spray systems -- please refer to manufacturer suggested setting for liquid slurries. Continued agitation is required for larger bottles. Do not mix higher than a 10% solution (1:10).

Dry Powder Bottle (Dry mixture)

(UPC #: 8-52779-00102-9, 8-52779-00103-6, 8-52779-00104-3)

Dry powder best applied with a hand held dusting unit or with larger industrial power duster. For best coverage, provide pressurized air stream for powder to mix with. Apply powder at a downward angle to the turf, crop, ornamental plant. Do not apply powder during windy conditions (>10 mph). Best if applied in morning or after watering or rain shower.

Apply C-M PowderGard as a broadcast powder or spray with suitable and calibrated application equipment to give complete and uniform coverage of pest infested areas. Following the suggested application rates:

Fleas & Ticks: (Including but not limited to Adult Cat Flea, Lone Star Tick, Deer Tick & Brown Dog Tick) Apply as either a Dust or Spray to affected area as suggested. C-M PowderGard can also be used in outdoor applications under mostly dry conditions. Reapply after rain or excessively humid conditions.

Ants: (Fire Ants, Pharaoh and other common household ants) For Fire Ants apply a layer at least 1/2 inch thick around the entrance of the mound. In wet or windy areas, make a 50/50 slurry of C-M PowderGard and water and pump directly into the mound. It will take approximately 2-3 days for the entire ant population to be eliminated. For Pharaoh and other common household ants, you can treat the mound as well as areas where ants are seen trafficking and cracks and crevices where they may enter structures. Caution: there is no immediate knockdown with C-M PowderGard. If ants become agitated during application, ants

Flies (including White Flies): Use in areas where flies congregate; greenhouses, barns, stalls, garbage areas, etc and basements. Apply C-M PowderGard at recommended dosages and reapply after heavy rain, washing or excessively humid conditions.

Perimeter Treatment: Apply a 6-12 inch band around affected room, building, storage facility. Concentrate on known locations where insect traffic is present. Apply as a crack and crevice treatment in those areas.
